1st edition of Quizathon (Annual Quiz Competition) was conducted on 13th June'24 for students of III and IV BPTh batches highlighting Physiotherapeutic assessment and management techniques in Cardiovascular & Respiratory conditions. Dr. Pranjal Grover, Dr. Vijayendra Rajguru and Dr. Varsha Badwe inaugurated the quiz competition with lamp-lighting and short prayer. Opening remarks were delivered by Dr. Pranjal Grover, Principal, LTCOP. Dr. Varsha Badwe, Campus coordinator (TMV Campus, Kharghar) spoke few wise words of motivation for the students. Dr. Vijayendra Rajguru, Head of Department, Cardiovascular And Respiratory Physiotherapy Department raised the enthusiasm and energy for the quiz with his inaugural speech.

Total 30 students (15- III BPT and 15 - IV BPT) participated for the quiz, divided in 5 teams of 6 participants each. The quiz was conducted in 5 rounds - Pictorial, Auditory, Case based, Rapid fire and Repeat pictorial rounds. Team Lung Legends won the first prize with total score of 51/100 followed by Team Pulmonary Powerhouse with total score of 42/100. Students were awarded with medals and certificates and participants were appreciated for their enthusiastic participation. This newer method of teaching - learning was received well by all students. Students gave feedback to have more such sessions that helped them develop interest in the subject.
