- **About the Library-** The Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth library was established in 1965. The library is considered an integral part in the academic activities of the Vidyapeeth. It has a collection of more than 100000 books and subscribes to 124 periodicals (Indian & Foreign) on subjects like Social Sciences, Sanskrit, Literature, Philosophy, Religion, Indology, Ayurveda, Management, Hotel Management, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Law, Library Science etc. The library provides services to all the students, research scholars, teaching and non-teaching staff of this Vidyapeeth. It also has a rich collection of 2270 manuscripts. Scanning & digitization of manuscripts has been completed. The library operations are fully automated with SLIM-21 software.
